## **Electronic Scoresheet Use**

► The only electronic devices that are allowed for use to record your score are MonRoi, eNotate or Plycounter. Any and all other electronic devices are prohibited.

► Your device can never leave the table while your game is in progress and must remain flat on the table at all times.

• You may only use your device to record a move that has already been made on the board. You may not make a move on your device in advance.

## **Penalties For Violations of Above Rules:**

(Cumulative during the course of the tournament.)

First Penalty - 10 minutes or half of your remaining time deducted from your clock, whichever is less.

Second Penalty - Forfeiture of current game.

Third Penalty - Forfeiture of tournament with no refund of entry fee or awarding of prize money.

**Immediate Forfeiture Penalty** - Using your device to analyze during your game (the third penalty above).
