

Electronic Scoresheet Use

- ▶ The only electronic devices that are allowed for use to record your score are **MonRoi**, **eNotate** or **Plycounter**. Any and all other electronic devices are prohibited.
- ▶ Your device can never leave the table while your game is in progress and must remain flat on the table at all times.
- ▶ You may only use your device to record a move that has already been made on the board. You may not make a move on your device in advance.

Penalties For Violations of Above Rules:

(Cumulative during the course of the tournament.)

First Penalty - 10 minutes or half of your remaining time deducted from your clock, whichever is less.

Second Penalty - Forfeiture of current game.

Third Penalty - Forfeiture of tournament with no refund of entry fee or awarding of prize money.

Immediate Forfeiture Penalty - Using your device to analyze during your game (the third penalty above).

If your device malfunctions, you may not attempt to “reset” it, you must then record your remaining moves manually on a paper scoresheet for the rest of the current game. (This is not a penalty.)
